This is an example of a one page abstract fitting to the needs for publishing in the collection of abstracts [1]. Language is English. The abstracts may contain graphical results that support the written arguments but shall not exceed a length of 1 page (A4 format), margins: top- 20 mm, bottom- 20 mm, left- 30 mm, right- 20 mm. The accepted abstracts will be available as a handout during the conference.

Manuscript should be typed with single spacing using Microsoft Word processor, font – Times New Roman. The title line is all caps, 14pt bold and centred. Author-lines are 12pt, normal and centred. Presenting author is underlined. Abstract text is 12pt, normal and justified. References are 10pt, normal and left. Caption is 12pt, normal, justified and italic.

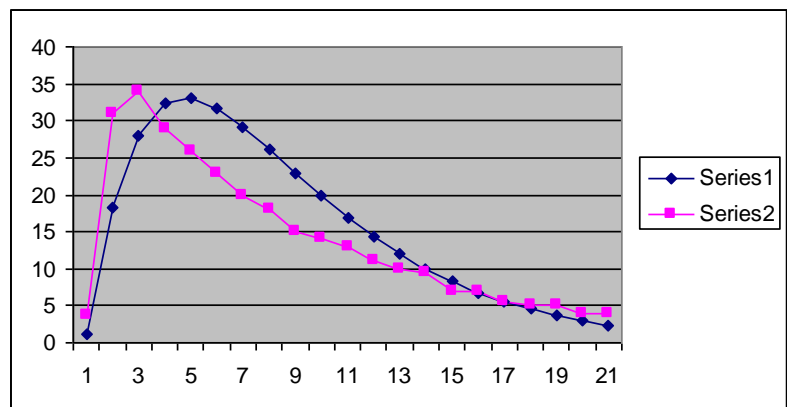


Figure 1. The graph of tension (Series2) and the empirical curve (Series1)
